Titled "To challenge the Earth, the Moon, the Sun & the Stars," the exhibition is conceived, as in past years, as an homage to Manzoni, and to all artists "who accepted the challenge of turning our world upside down," reads the press release.

Headed by Mattijs Visser, founding director of ZERO foundation, the curatorial team includes Olivier Varenne, Jean-Hubert Martin, Daniel Birnbaum, and Maria Finders. Each of the five curators have been allotted a "chapter," based on a work by Manzoni.

"The fact that Manzoni, with his epoch-making residency in Herning, produced art that made world history, obviously begs a gathering up of the past and continuously challenging the future, specifically here in Herning", says Holger Reenberg, Director at Herning Museum of Contemporary Art (HEART), which is hosting the Biennale.
