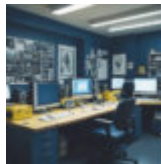

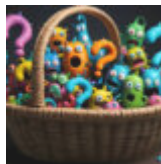
Yannick Demmerle has been our resident artist for the past eight months and has produced 10 large-scale drawings in pencil.

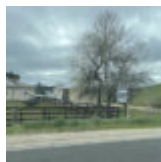

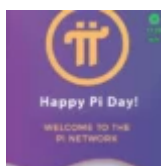

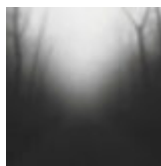
